Dear PMEA District 7 senior music students,

Greetings from PMEA District 7! We are pleased to be able to award scholarships for deserving District 7 music students at the end of the 2024-2025 school year. While our scholarships are primarily intended for those pursuing a career in music education, we encourage the application of students pursuing a career in ANY music field of study (i.e. performance, recording technology, etc.). PMEA festival experience, although not required, should be included where applicable.

An additional scholarship, the Robert F. Rhine Memorial Scholarship for Leadership and Service, honors Mr. Rhine's 44-year legacy as a music educator, track coach, PIAA Official, and Secretary-Treasurer of PMEA District 7. This scholarship will be awarded to a student who exemplifies leadership in service to their community and school. Service to music should also be included, but the primary emphasis of this scholarship is on service contributions to organizations outside of their school music programs. Applicants must be a current senior, but can be planning a major in any field of study.

**The deadline to apply for a scholarship is April 15, 2025** (the application window will open February 1, 2025). Applicants will be considered in all scholarship areas for which they qualify and apply, but each student is eligible to be awarded a maximum of one scholarship. The amount of each scholarship is \$1,000. The application can be found on the PMEA District 7 website.
